OFFSHORE GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULE CHANGE

In the spirit of competition, the SSFC Board has approved the new General Tournament Rule for Areas A, B and C. It includes an expanded time to fish. Fishing will be open one week before the general tournament through the day of the general tournament (Saturday-Saturday).

Captains will have to inform a designated SSFC board member by 6am the day they fish with the names of all aboard, this can be done via email, text or phone call. Any captain/boat/crew who has registered for a fish day will not be eligible to fish again that week for the general tournament.

Fish caught during the period before the actual general tournament day must be weighed in at a predetermined location between the hours of 5:30-7pm of the registered fishing day.

All weather rules are still in effect for any day during the timeframe of the tournament. All Captains are responsible for the safety of their crew and vessel.
