NEW GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULE CHANGE

For young anglers 14 years and younger fishing in the Inshore Area, any fish species listed on the SSFC Tournament Scoring Sheet up to a limit of five fish including eligible release fish may be weighed-in during General Tournaments. The young angler point total will be calculated using the scoring system indicated on the SSFC Tournament Scoring Sheet and will determine the angler's placement against other young anglers in the Inshore Area. Trout, Red Drum, and Flounder caught by the young angler in the Inshore Area may be entered toward boat and non-young angler General Tournament competition if desired.
